


Laupus Library (left), the School of Allied Health Sciences (center), and the School of Nursing (right) received \$60 million from the North Carolina higher education facilities bond fund.



This expanded clientele resulted in heavier library use and a change in focus for the library's teaching programs.






The new library was planned to house existing print collections in a pleasing environment conducive to study, research and learning.
