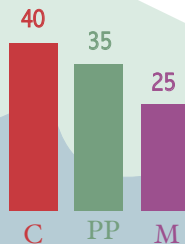

Purpose

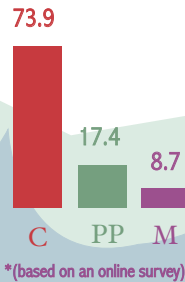
Our purpose was to determine the most appropriate software for creating and delivering online tutorials that will demonstrate effective database searching skills to the users of Laupus Library.

(in minutes)



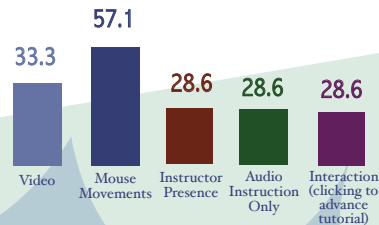
* (time determined by experienced creators)

(by percent)



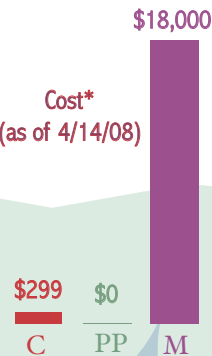
* (based on an online survey)

(as of 4/14/08)



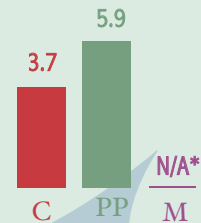
* (cost based on users with Microsoft Office)
