
Mission Priority 1: Student Success - We offer transformative experiences for all students during their time at ECU and beyond.

<u>Select a University Mission Priority Objective:</u> M1.2: Expand access to and participation in transformative experiences and experiential learning.

- 1. The Laupus Library will promote opportunities for internships at the library and Country Doctor Museum to appropriate ECU academic departments which will lead to an increase in experiential learning opportunities for ECU students.
- 2. The library's Virtual Reality Lab and 3D printing service are sites for experience and transformative learning, and the library will encourage their use by hosting workshops to encourage and support creative use of both technologies by ECU students
